Exploratory:

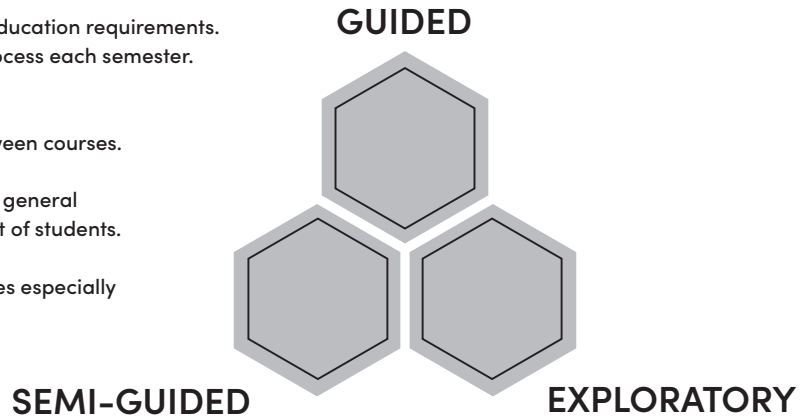
This mode allows you to truly explore connections between courses.
